Boys lead the boys and the adults make sure no one gets hurt when something explodes. *Troop 80 Scouts wrote this letter.*

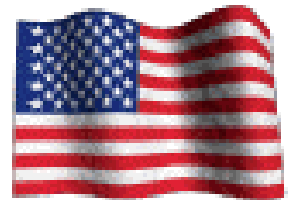
We play a game at every meeting.
